Approval to Add Possible Community Block Grant Project to Weber County's Capital Improvements for 2017 thru 2021

As part of the CDBG process, non-profit agencies that may request sponsorship through the county for CDBG funds need to be added to our capital needs for 2018 thru 2022. The adoption of the capital improvement plan must take place after the public hearing.

The Weber Housing Authority has asked for the County's sponsorship for a CDBG Project in 2018. They did have someone at the How To Apply Meeting and are eligible to make application should the County sponsor them.

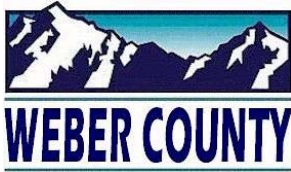

ADDITION TO WEBER COUNTY CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS FOR 2017 THRU 2021

Additions to Weber County section of capital improvements for 2018:

In addition to Weber County's more extensive capital improvements list, the following are projects that may seek Community Development Block Grant Funds for 2018.

There is one agency that has requested Weber County sponsor them for 2018 projects. Following is the agency and a brief description of their projects:

1. Weber County Housing Authority – The Weber Housing Authority is interested in applying for funding to purchase a small multi-family property to rehab then rent to a low income households in Weber County. The property will assist the Weber Housing Authority in transitioning to self-sufficiency and will allow a low income families to reside in the unit at an affordable rate.
2. Weber County- We are looking to apply for funds to update the County's Moderate Income Plan

The following Weber County Project is proposed for 2018 THRU 2022:

Install ADA compliant sidewalk curb ramps at intersections in the Wheat Ridge Subdivision in Weber County.

Additional Needs

1. As stated in Weber County's original consolidated Plan / Capital Improvements Plan, Weber County continues to support non-profit organizations.
2. ADA Standards are always evolving and continual rehabilitation of facilities may be necessary to keep facilities compliant with new standards. Weber County will strive to stay ADA compliant with ADA upgrade projects as may be required.
3. Infrastructure upgrades, pedestrian facilities near and around schools for pedestrian safety and for non-motorized transportation needs, upgrades to water systems within county parks to ensure safe drinking water, and possible sewer projects.
4. Storm Water Flood Control is always a critical need. Because of the nature of floods, the location of flooding is not always predictable and a specific project solution is not known.
5. Implement a program to assist low income families or families at risk.
