NOTICE OF 2025 BUSINESS PERSONAL PROPERTY TAX FILING

Dear Taxpayer:

In accordance with the provisions set forth under the Revenue and Taxation laws of the State of Utah, taxable business entities are required to pay Personal Property Tax. Such tax is levied against all personal property (business equipment) in Weber County on January 1 of each year. Our records indicate you are a leasing company and lease business equipment in Weber County. Statutes require you to report all business assets, except Real Property (land and buildings) you own as of January 1, 2025, on the enclosed statement.

Enclosed with your packet is a summarized list of equipment reported in 2024. Please refer to the valuation schedules to correctly classify and depreciate your assets. For each tax district, a tax rate is listed for you to multiply by the total market value in that district to arrive at the tax amount due. For new locations, please visit <u>www.webercountyutah.gov/Assessor/pproperty.php</u> and click "Find Your Tax Rate" for the correct tax district and tax rate.

Note: Please provide a complete asset detail with the names and addresses of the companies or individuals you lease to in Weber County only. This list can be submitted electronically by emailing the equipment listing to weberleasing@webercountyutah.gov in Excel format. No PDF files, please.

New for 2025: (1) The Utah Legislature shifted all non-mobile flight equipment from centrally assessed to locally assessed (Utah Code 59-2-201 (1)). Non-mobile flight equipment includes assets such as but not limited to: Consumable Spare Parts, Plant and Equipment owned by Air Carrier, Non-Licensed Vehicles, Airport and Office Equipment. **(2)** In 2023, The Utah Legislature deemed supplies exempt from taxation. This exemption <u>does not</u> include expensed or capitalized items. Expensed and capitalized items must be reported.

Tax Exemption: (1) A business with an aggregate taxable value of **\$29,300** or less may be exempt from Personal Property Tax. Your application for exemption may only be considered with a completed Signed Statement of Personal Property. **(2)** If a business files and qualifies for the exemption, it is not required to file a signed statement for each continuing consecutive year unless the taxable value rises above the exemption threshold. Please note: You will be notified if your business has qualified for this exemption.

Your Signed Statement and tax payment are due on or before May 15, 2025. Past-due accounts will be subject to a penalty equal to 10% of the tax due but not less than \$25.00. Interest will accrue at 10% annually on all accounts not paid in full by May 15, 2025.

If your lease has ended, sold or you are no longer in business, please go to <u>www.webercountyutah.gov/Assessor/pproperty.php</u> and complete the online "Business Change Form."
