

**MINUTES OF THE WORK SESSION OF
THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF WEBER COUNTY**

Monday, February 9, 2026, from 1:00 p.m. to 1:45 p.m., held in the Commission Conference Room #365, Weber County Commission Office 2380 Washington Blvd, Ste. 360, Ogden, UT

Discussion and/or action for approval of minutes for the Commission Work Session held on February 2, 2026

Commissioner Bolos made a motion to approve the minutes for the Commission Work Session held on February 2, 2026. Commissioner Froerer seconded the motion. All voted aye. The motion carries.

Discussion regarding GRAMA Appeals Board members – Ernie Gonzales, Courtlan Erickson, Chris Crockett, Jessika Clark

Ernie Gonzales discussed increasing the number of alternate members on the GRAMA Appeals Board from two to three, including two public members and one county employee, to ensure better attendance at hearings and to prevent cancellations. Chris Crockett highlighted the growing number of appeals, particularly due to AI, and the need for additional alternates to manage the increased workload. Courtlan Erickson went over the policy, noting that adding new members to the Board coincides with the ordinance. The Commissioners agreed to proceed with appointing two additional public members, and Courtlan will update the ordinance accordingly.

Discussion regarding B&C Road Funds Application – Ashley Thoman, Sean Wilkinson, Chris Crockett, Jessika Clark

Ashley Thoman discussed the B&C Road Fund application. He presented updated road mileage numbers for the county, which included new paved roads in subdivisions and adjustments to gravel and dirt road classifications. He discussed the need to separate the numbers for the unincorporated part of Weber County and the numbers for the new city and mentioned that Ogden Valley City's road numbers have been reviewed and submitted to UDOT. The Commissioners agreed to sign off on the application.

Commissioner Bolos made a motion to saunter. Commissioner Froerer seconded the motion. All voted aye. The motion carries.

Discussion regarding Contract Renewal with Verifent – Emily Wilde, Chris Crockett, Jessika Clark

Emily Wilde presented a proposal to renew the contract with Verifent for another 5 years, explaining its role in streamlining employment and income verifications. As the Commissioners didn't have any questions, Emily will present this contract for them to approve at a future commission meeting.
