**A RESOLUTION OF THE WEBER COUNTY COMMISSION
ADOPTING THE PRE-DISASTER MITIGATION PLAN**

WHEREAS, Weber County recognizes the threat that natural hazards pose to people, property, and infrastructure within the County; and

WHEREAS, the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) requires that jurisdictions adopt a pre-disaster mitigation plan to remain eligible for certain federal disaster assistance and mitigation grant funding; and

WHEREAS, Weber County has conducted a comprehensive planning process that included input from stakeholders, residents, and local experts to identify and assess hazards, vulnerabilities, and mitigation strategies; and

WHEREAS, the County has prepared a multi-hazard mitigation plan, hereby known as the Weber County, Utah Pre-Disaster Mitigation Plan 2024 (Plan); and

WHEREAS, the Plan complies with federal laws, including the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act, as amended; the National Flood Insurance Act of 1968, as amended; and the National Dam Safety Program Act, as amended; and

WHEREAS, the Plan outlines goals, strategies, and actions to reduce or eliminate long-term risk to people and property in Weber County from the impacts of future hazards and disasters; and

WHEREAS, the Commission has reviewed the Plan and determined it aligns with the County's goals of enhancing public safety, reducing future risks, and improving preparedness and response capabilities;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE WEBER COUNTY COMMISSION, THAT:

Section 1. The Weber County, Utah Pre-Disaster Mitigation Plan 2024 is hereby adopted.

Section 2. The County affirms its commitment to implement the goals, strategies, and actions identified in the Plan.

Section 3. The County shall submit the adopted Plan to FEMA for final approval in accordance

with applicable regulations and requirements.

Section 4. Minor revisions required by Local Participating Governments or FEMA will not require Weber County to re-adopt the plan. Once the plan has been approved by FEMA, subsequent plan updates will require separate adoption resolutions.
