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
Brass cap monuments were found at the Northeast corner and the North Quarter corner of section 20, T6N, R3W, SLB&M. Rebars were found at the Northeast and Southeast corners of the property which corresponds to a survey done by Intermountain Surveying in August of 1992 (Weber County Surveyor filing No. 749). A rebar and cap marked CLS was found at the Southwest corner of the property which corresponds to the location of the Russel's Run subdivision (weber County Recorder No. 2049935). A line bearing North 89°41'19" West between the top section corner monument was used
