



The field survey work for this survey was performed in December of 2011. The basis of bearing for this survey is a line which bears North 89'56'00" West between two 1944 G.L.O. Section Corner Monuments at the Northeast Corner and the North Quarter Corner of Section 5, T6N, R3E, S.L.B.&M. The monuments used for the Basis of Bearing were found in place, according to a dependent resurvey of Township 7 North, Range 3 East, accepted on October 2nd, 1947. A number of highway right of way markers were located along this section of Utah State Route 39. Specifically, the 40.00 foot North offset and 33.00 foot South offset right of way markers located at station 253+81.00 and the 40.00 foot South offset right of way marker located at station 250+76.00 were held to affix the center line, and right of way lines, of said Route 39 to the ground. On October 20th, 2005, Record of Survey number 3507 was filed in the office of the Weber County Surveyor. Said survey number 3507 was a retracement survey of almost all of the property lines in this Cottonwood Grove area. A number of the property corners from said survey number 3507 were found on the ground and were held to affix all of its property lines to the ground for this survey. Apart from

locations, shapes, or dimensions of these features as shown hereon. Diane Call gave parol testimony that all of her life her family has owned parcel 23–008–0008 and she has visited this area with her family throughout the length of her entire life. She stated that in all that time she has only used, and known of, one access road from Utah State Route 39 into the Cottonwood Grove area. She stated that the access road, which has always been used, is the existing access road, as shown hereon. She stated that the access road is in the same location as it has always been, except for some minor changes made in the fall of 2010 to its location through parcel 23–021–0008. She also stated that she has never seen, or heard of, any other ingress or egress access to the Cottonwood Grove area. Her parol testimony has been affirmed by my client LeRoy Palmer, and would no doubt be affirmed by any other person with a long standing personal knowledge of the history of this area and its access road.

Owning to the fact that this is a Record of Survey defining the location of an existing access road, and because the continued use of the road will perpetuate its definition as a monument in and of itself, no additional monuments were set in conjunction with this survey at this time.
