

THIS STATEMENT IS A NOTICE OF YOUR PROPERTY VALUATION

This Notice is not a bill. The Weber County Treasurer will send your Tax Bill in October. If you have questions about tax payments, pre-paid tax amounts, and delinquent taxes, call the Treasurer's Office at the number listed below.

Why am I receiving this Notice?

- To inform you of the Assessor's classification and value for this property and your opportunity to appeal.
- To show you a comparison of last year's and this year's value, tax rates and tax amounts.
- To notify you of an entity's intent to raise taxes above the amount allowed by law (Utah Code 59-2-919).
- To let you know how your tax dollars are allocated to the various government organizations in your area.

This Notice does NOT include:

- Pre-payments made to your 2020 property taxes.
- Tax Relief adjustments (See the list of Tax Relief programs below).
- Any delinquent property taxes you may owe.

What do the different columns on the other side of the page mean?

Property Type – The type and classification of your property. This may affect taxable value. Last Year's Market Value – The value of your property on January $1^{
m st}$ of last year

Last Year's Taxable Value – The value of your property that you were taxed on for last year.

This Year's Market Value – The value of your property on January $1^{
m st}$ of this year

This Year's Taxable Value – The value of your property that you will be taxed on for this year.

Tax Entities – The government organizations that charge you a tax for the area you live in.

Taxes Last Year – The tax rate and tax amount entities set for last year.

No Budget Increase – The tax rate and tax amount allowed for this year without advertising for a tax increase Proposed Budget Amount – The tax rate and tax amount the entities are requesting for this year.

NOTE: To compute the dollar amount of taxes charged, multiply the tax rate by the taxable value.

Changes and Public Hearings – The dollar amount of proposed increase, percent of increase, and date, time place of required meetings for entities raising their tax above the allowed amount.

Do I qualify for Tax Relief?

You may be eligible for one or more Tax Relief programs. For additional information about Tax Relief programs, visit the Weber County website at www.WeberCountyUtah.gov/Clerk_Auditor/tax_relief.php or call (801) 399-8400.

- Circuit Breaker Program If you are age 66 or older, or a widow/widower of any age, and your 2019 total household income was less than \$34,168 you may qualify for the Circuit Breaker Program.
 - Abatement Program If you are experiencing extreme financial hardship and/or you have a medical disability, you may qualify for the Abatement Program.
- Veteran With A Disability Exemption If you are a veteran with a service-related disability of 10% or more, or are the unmarried surviving spouse or minor orphan of a deceased veteran with a service-related disability of 10% or more, you may qualify for tax relief on real and/or personal property.
 - Deployed Military Personnel If you served outside the state for 200 days (consecutive or cumulative) for qualifying active duty military service, you may be eligible for tax relief.
 - Blind Exemption If you are blind, or are the unmarried surviving spouse or minor orphan of a deceased blind person, you may qualify for tax relief on real and/or personal property.
